classifications will receive a Championship medal even if competing solo. All others must be within 5% of the Swedish record inorder to receive the Championship medal. Ann's and Glenn's Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the best female and male performer, with

regards to MASTERS FINA POINTS.

SM points:

Swedish clubs as specified in SSF Rule 310: "Points are awarded for results in SM in Masters swimming, with 7, 5 and 3 points being awarded for the first three (Swedish) club participants in each event and age class, provided that at least three participants from at least

two (Swedish) clubs started in the event. Team points are awarded

only in events in which at least two teams from at least two Swedish clubs have participated in the event."

It is important that each suit can easily be identified by manufacturer & model. Most 2010 approved suits have a symbol showing that they

are FINA approved.
